## Summary

The San Francisco Bay Conservation and Development Commission (BCDC), created in the 1960's out of the public's concern for the planned filling of San Francisco Bay, was designed and has worked to build regional consensus on the values of the Bay and the actions needed by public and private entities to manage and protect the Bay for current and future Californians.
